Broadacre achieved the fourth highest result in the city, with 86% of our Year 6 pupils achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined in 2018. This is an amazing achievement for the school - well done to all staff and pupils!

Road Closures

As already announced on the Kingswood Neighbourhood Network, a section of Wawne Road will be closed from 14 January 2019 for approximately six weeks. This closure will affect the access to the school, as it includes the stretch from Ings Lane (Chalky Lane) to Pioneer Way. There will be a diversion in place, following Pennine Way from the Kingswood roundabout to Wawne Road.
